Convocation

St. omas Universit 's Convocation is a gathering of the universit communit to confer degrees, present awards and medals, and hear the Address to Graduates and Valedictor . Convocation begins with a processional led b graduating students who are followed b facult , universit o cials, and special guests. Each group occupies a designated position and the processional becomes a meeting of the universit , the de nition of convocation. Modern universit attire dates to the Middle Ages when scholars and students were members of religious orders. e Chancellor and the President wear ceremonial St. omas Universit robes designed for their o ce, while man facult wear the hoods and gowns of their

e universit bestows honorar degrees on individuals who have been deemed deserving of recognition b a Joint Board of Governors-Senate Committee. Wearing green and gold-trimmed robes, St. omas Universit 's colours, the recipients receive hoods s mboli ing their degrees. Students who have met the universit 's academic standards are similarl hooded and formall granted all the honours, rights, and privileges pertaining to their degree.

Eagle Feather


Graduating Indigenous students were gi ed with Eagle Feathers at a special ceremon and are carr ing their feather as the receive their degree. In Indigenous communities, there is a sacred connection between the Eagle and the Creator as the Eagle ies highest and closest to the Creator and carries human pra ers. In e Stor of the Eagle Feather, the Eagle o ered one of its feathers to the human famil as a sign of continued love and healing and a reminder of the importance of Sacred Teachings. To be given an Eagle Feather bestows honour and responsibilit as it s mboli es being a messenger for respect, truth, courage, and wisdom as passed down b Elders.

Kente Stole

e Black Students' Association has worked with the universit to introduce the Kente Stole to Convocation to commemorate the dierences and obstacles STUs Black students overcome in order to graduate. Adapted from African tradition in Ghana, this woven cloth, which was once onleworn be roalt, is a scarf-like garment worn over the shoulder that represents an accomplishment, graduation, or other rite of passage. e Kente Stole honours the legac of Black ancestors and is a testament to each graduate's strength and excellence.

Honorary Degree Recipients

Dr. Mary McCarthy-Brandt is a Fredericton-based writer, educator, and historian dedicated to preserving the histories of Black New Brunswickers. Over the past decade, she has emerged as a prominent public commentator and has promoted greater awareness of the historical and current contributions of Black New Brunswickers. McCarth -Brandt is a sixth-generation New Brunswicker whose famil 's roots predate the



founding of the province in 1784. A PhD graduate of the Universit of Toronto's Ontario Institute for Studies in Education, her scholarl research focused on segregated and forgotten grave ards in New Brunswick. She also served for six ears as the president of the New Brunswick Black Histor Societ.

McCarth -Brandt has been featured in the provincial and regional media for her research locating and restoring abandoned Black cemeteries and her knowledge of the Black experience in New Brunswick. She chairs REACH NB (Remembering Each African Cemeteries Histor in New Brunswick) which collaborates with the Provincial Archives to locate and document forgotten and abandoned gravesites. In 2015, McCarth -Brandt won a human rights case against Shoppers Drug Mart for an incident of racial pro ling. Her writing was featured in the collection *B.* (Universit of Regina Press 2019), an antholog of African-Canadian writing on contemporar issues. She was also featured in *C* as one of 33 Black Canadians Making Change Now. for her work identif ing s stemic and anti-black racism.

Maggie Paul is a Passamaquodd elder, teacher, and song carrier who has lived most of her adult life on the St. Mar 's First Nation. She is known for her beautiful singing voice, her work preserving traditional songs, and using music to inspire and guide Indigenous outh. For more than 40 ears, she has been preserving and resurrecting Passamaquodd and Wolastoge songs that were once banned b the Gov-



ernment of Canada. Along with Wolastoq ik singer Rok Wiseman, she spent one ear listening to recorded songs from the late 1800s and earl 1900s that were preserved on wax c linders in the Canadian Museum of Histor. As the songs were onl accessible in the archives, Paul recorded two albums of these traditional songs and thus returned them to her people. In 2014, she was awarded an Indspire Award in the categor of culture, heritage, and art.

Paul also uses music to help oung Indigenous people nd their voices.

Most notabl, she mentored Indigenous musician Jerem Dutcher and when Dutcher accepted the Polaris Pri e for his album

in 2018, he thanked Paul who was also his guest at the awards gala. As Paul once said, When ou bring the songs back, ou're going to bring the dances back. You're going to bring the people back. You're going to bring ever thing back. She has dedicated her life to unearthing and reviving these forgotten melodies to bring them back to her communit so that it can feel whole again.
